ACADEMIC HONORS

SUMMA CUM LAUDE denotes a superior scholarship record with a grade point average of 3.95 or higher and successful completion of Departmental Honors. MAGNA CUM LAUDE is awarded to those who attain a 3.85 or higher average. CUM LAUDE is awarded to those who attain a minimum 3.50 average in all college coursework. Students who have met the scholarship standard but not the other honor requirements are listed HONORABLE MENTION. A black and orange braid is worn by graduates receiving degrees with honors.

THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The academic costume, which adds interest and color to these commencement exercises, is as old in history as are colleges and universities – that is, more than 800 years old. In the preceding centuries where there was no central heating, these served many practical purposes.

In today's academic procession, the style of gown and the hood of each faculty member indicate the degree held by the individual. The velvet neckcloth hue denotes the degree and the satin lining colors are those of the college or university from which the wearer was graduated.

Each college attempts to maintain distinctiveness of design. Greenville University is the only American institution with the black and single orange chevron hood. The most recent regalia designed for Greenville University are the robes worn by the Board of Trustees. The black robes with four orange veltesa bars on wide, cuffed sleeves and panels of the same fabric extending down the front, were first worn in November 1970, at the inauguration of the seventh president of the University.
